The letters of the alphabet always have the same order. This order is called the **alphabetical order**.

The letters a, e, i, o, u are **vowels**. The other letters are **consonants**.

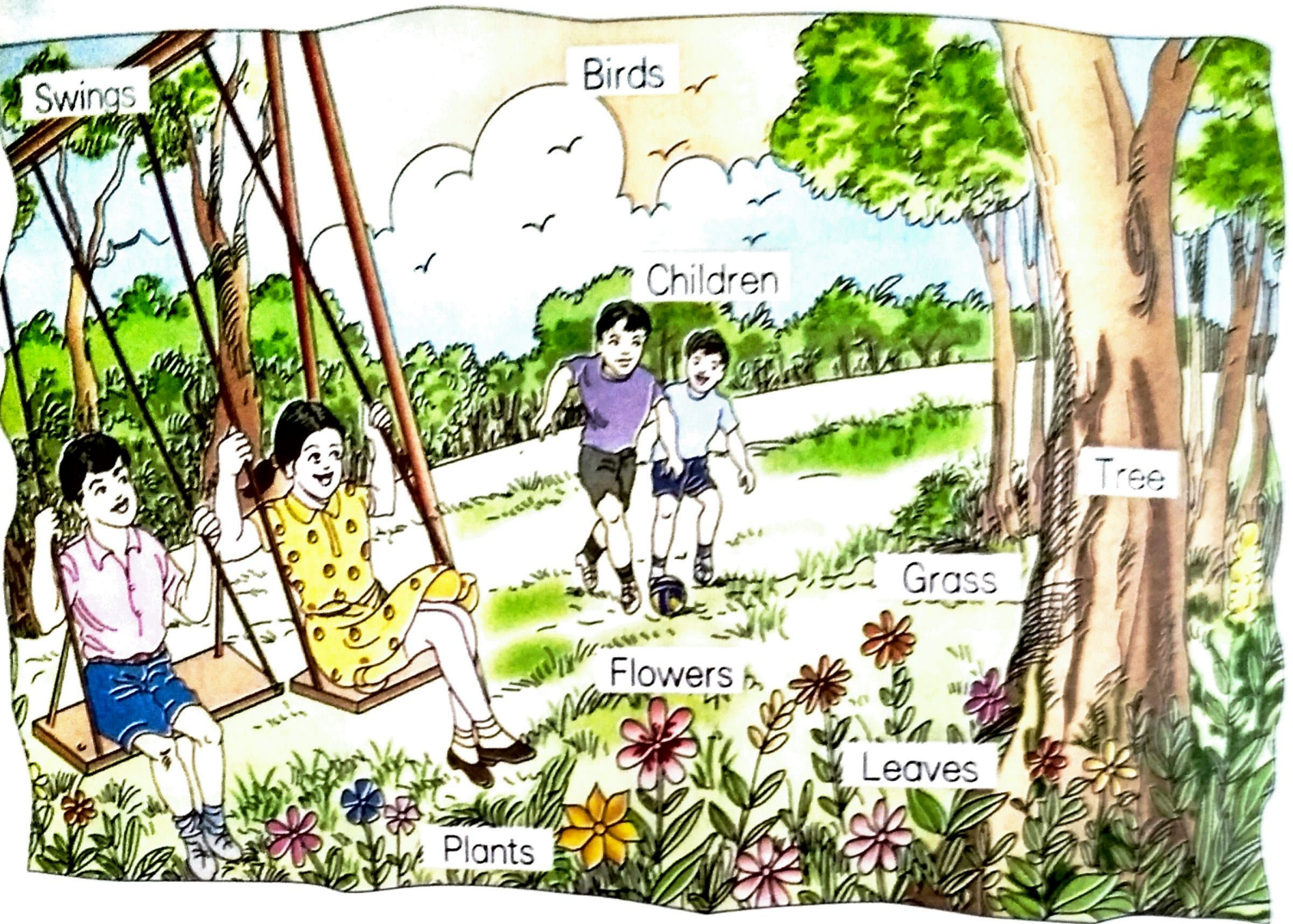
