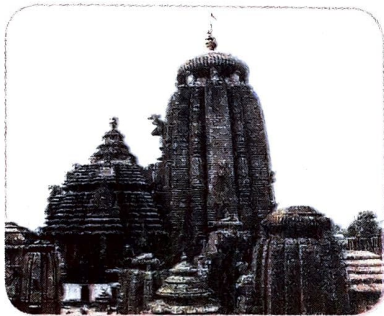
## Famous Indian Cities
