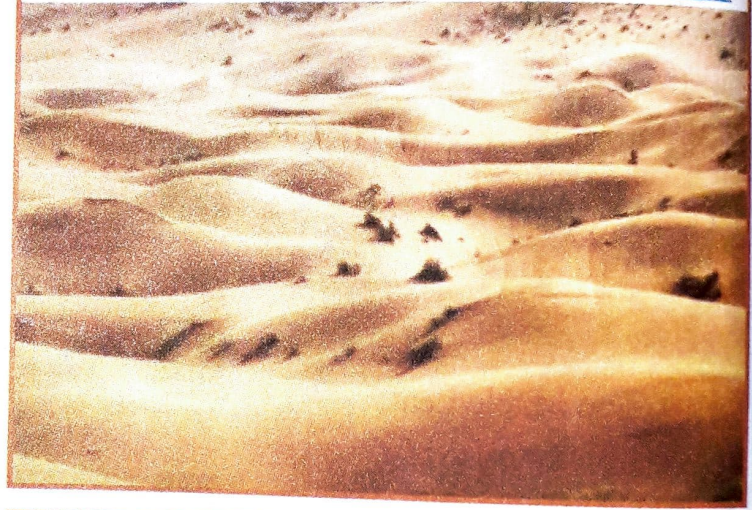
1. It is the tallest mountain in the world and lies in Nepal. It is a part of the Himalayan Mountain ranges.

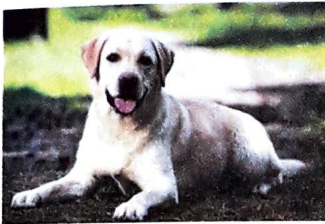

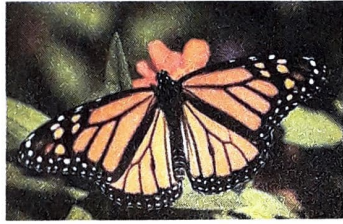
