The texture means smoothness or roughness of the surface of an object. Let's observe the different types of textures.



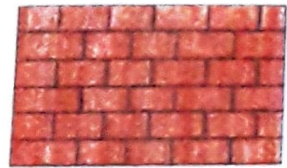

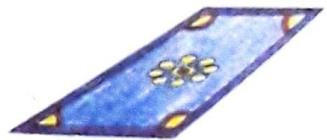
