6. He is my first cousin. He isn't my first cousin.
7. They paid the bill. They didn't pay the bill.
8. We believe her. We do not believe her.

10. This medicine might cure your cough. *This medicine might not cure your cough.*
11. There was a very large crowd. *There wasn't a large crowd.*
12. She can swim very well. *She can not swim very well.*
13. We have an English lesson every day. *We do not have Eng. lesson every day.*
14. You should always eat what you like. *You should not always eat what you like.*
15. You are learning English grammar. *You aren't learning Eng grammar.*
