4. The strength of Rajya Sabha is fixed at 250 members. 238 are elected members who represent the state and union territories and 12 members are nominated by the president.

G. 1. The Parliament keeps a check on the ministers and their works. If the parliament is not satisfied with the work of the ministers, the Lok Sabha pass a vote of no-confidence. This is passed to remove the government from the power.

2. The functions of the Parliament are:

- a. Law-making body: It frames new law, and amends or repeals them.
- b. Financial control: parliament exercises control over the government's incomes and its expenditure.
- c. Control over Executive: The parliament keeps check on the ministers and their work.
- d. Judicial Functions: The parliament has certain judicial powers also in case it is found violating the constitution.
- e. Electoral Function: The parliament plays an important role in the election of the president and the vice-president.
