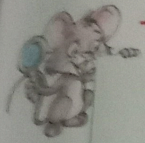


### Fact File

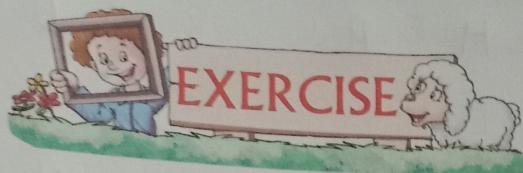


- Father is the head of a small family.
