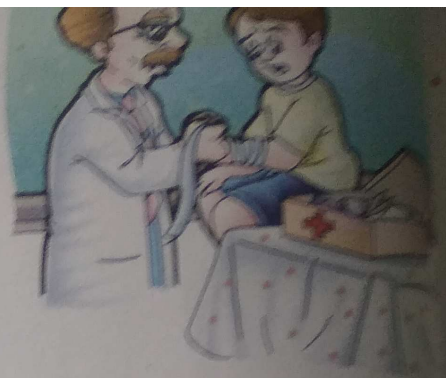


ON GETTING HURT

If you get hurt at home, tell your elders immediately. If you get hurt at school, tell your teachers. If any other person gets hurt, call your elders immediately.



The immediate treatment given to an injured person before proper medical aid is called **FIRST AID**.

In the First Aid box we keep things like bandage, cotton, dettol, scissors, antiseptic cream etc.



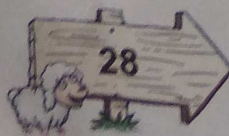
Things to Remember
